## **Stockholm and the opera festival of Dalhalla**

### **Day 1, Wednesday 13th of August: Stockholm**

Arrival of the group at Arlanda Airport. Transfer to the hotel. 2 overnight stays in the Stockholm region.

### **Day 2, Thursday 14th of August: Stockholm and Drottningholm**

The day starts with a citysightseeing (09-12 a.m.), where you will see the many faces of Stockholm.

You will see the City Hall, a masterpiece of 20th century architecture and the scene of the annual Nobelprice dinner. You will pass the Old Town with its narrow streets and lanes and the wonderful old buildings.

From Fjällgatan, you can enjoy the beautiful panorama of the city and the islands. In the afternoon you will visit the theater of Drottningholm castle.

The theater dates back to 1754, had its „golden days“ under the reign of King Gustav III (1777 –1792) and is today the oldest theater in Europe that is still in use. Afterwards you have the possibility to visit the castle itself as well.

### **Day 3, Friday 15th of August: Dalarna**

A local coach and guide will accompany you to Dalarna. In Falun, you will visit the copper mines, which are on the UNESCO-list of world heritage. In the evening you will see Verdis' „Rigoletto“ (tickets for section C) in Dalhalla.

Dalhalla is one of the most beautiful open air stages in the world. It is situated in an abandoned lime mine, in the middle of the woods and just a couple of kilometers north of Rättvik.

With its inimitable acoustics and the silence surrounding it, Dalhalla is the perfect place to practice and experience music.
