## Stavechurches in Norway

### Day 1 Arrival

Arrival at the airport Gardermoen in Oslo. Transfer with bus and guide to your hotel.

### Day 2 Oslo

A local guide will show you the capital of Norway. You will, among other things, see the city hall, the fortress Åkershus, the Vigeland park and the museum island Bygdøy. Entrance to the Vikingship museum with the vikingships "Gokstad", „Tune“ and "Oseberg,, which were excavated close to the Oslofjord. The building technique for the vikingships is very important for the construction of the stave churches.

After that you will visit the Norwegian Folkmuseum with 150 buildings, among them the famous Gol stavechurch and farmsteads from almost all regions.

### Day 3 Numedal

East of Notodden and Kongsberg you can find the largest still preserved stave church in the world – Heddal. Especially worth seeing are the rich ornaments on the door frames and the numerous complex wall paintings from the 14th century. Afterwards you drive on through the Numedal, past the stave churches of Rollag, Nore and Uvdal.

Overnight stay in Geilo.

### Day 4 Sognefjord

Through the Hemsevalley you arrive at the stavechurch of Borgund. In Borgund, you will find one of best preserved stave churches of the country. The church was built around 1150. Continue to the stavechurch of Kaupanger from 1180 in the Basilika style. Situated on the Lusterfjord is the stavechurch of Urnes. Overnight in Hafslo.

### Day 5 Gudbrandstal

The stave church of Lom is situated in the village by the same name north of the Jotunheim mountains. It is dated late 12th century and can surely be counted as one of the most beautiful ones.

The stavechurch of Ringebu is counted as one of the largest Norwegian stavechurches, carried by 12 masts. Overnight stay in Lillehammer.

### Day 6 Return

Today you visit the Maihaugen Museum. In this open air museum you find the stave church of Garmo, which was taken there in 1920.
