

310 The Golden Triangle

If you really want to get to know the 3 capitals of Scandinavia, you will need some time on your hands. During this tour you will take your time to see all the places of interest and enjoy the diversity of Scandinavia.

Tag 1: Arrival in Copenhagen

You start your journey in Puttgarden and take the ferry to Rødby before you travel on to Copenhagen. Here you will check in into your hotel for the following 2 nights.

Day 2: Copenhagen

On your second day, you leave the hotel after breakfast and take part in a 3-hour city sightseeing tour. The city guide will show you the most beautiful parts of the city as for example the town hall square, the Town Hall itself, the “astronomical world-time-clock”, Amalienborg Castle or the “Little Mermaid”. The capital of Denmark is without a doubt one of the most charming cities of the world.

Day 3: Copenhagen – Oslo

Before you go onboard of the DFDS ferry in the afternoon which will bring you to Oslo, you will have the chance to explore Copenhagen yourself and visit one of the museums or linger around in the Old Town passing castles, parks and churches. Overnight stay onboard the comfortable ferry.

Day 4: Oslo

After your breakfast you leave the ferry in Oslo, Norway’s capital. You take part in a 3-hours city tour and the tour guide will be delighted to show you all important sights Oslo has to offer such as the Opera House, Town Hall, Vigeland park and the Akershus fortress. The afternoon is reserved for your own activities. You have the possibility to take a closer look at all the sightseeing facilities you are interested in e.g. one of the 50 museums and galleries or you linger around in the amusement area of Aker Brygge.

Day 5: Oslo – Örebro (ca. 330 km)

After breakfast you leave Oslo and travel on to your next destination: Örebro. In Örebro, many “Reichstag” took place in the 15th century and the castle on an island which is located in the middle of the town acts as the town’s landmark. Overnight stay in the Örebro area.

Day 6: Örebro – Stockholm (ca. 200 km)

Today you will travel to Stockholm, Sweden’s beautiful capital, built on 14 islands. Here you will join a 3-hour city tour where you will see all important sights the city has to offer. You will pass the Royal Castle, the Stadhuset and the picturesque Old Town of “Gamla Stan” and get a good overview of the city. The remaining afternoon is reserved for your own activities. Linger around the old town, have some coffee in one of the many cozy cafés or visit the Vasa Museum or Skansen on the island of Djurgården.

Day 7: Stockholm – Ängelholm (ca. 550 km)

After breakfast you will leave Stockholm and travel towards the south west of Sweden where Ängelholm is located. Ängelholm is well-known for its salmon fishing and its

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cuckoo flutes made of clay. The small town houses a nice museum for handcrafts and additionally to that a part of the Swedish Train Museum is located there as well.

Day 8: Ängelholm – Fehmarn

On your last day you will travel over the Öresund-Bridge from Malmö to Copenhagen. Then you continue your journey to Rødby where you take the ferry back to Puttgarden in Germany.
