

707 Authentic Norway

It is just as easy to discover the fantastic nature of Norway by comfortable trains and ships! There are many possibilities to combine the most beautiful railway stretches and unforgettable cruises through the fjords or along the rugged coast. This way of traveling is particularly suitable for exciting winter trips as well!

Day 1: Arrival in Oslo by plane

After you arrived by plane, a coach will pick you up at Oslo airport and bring you to the centrally located hotel. The remaining day is reserved for your own interests.

Day 2: Oslo – Trondheim (495 km)

After the breakfast at your hotel, you will leave Oslo by train and travel towards the north. Enjoy the beautiful and varying landscape which you can see through the panoramic windows such as Lake Mjøsa, the Olympic city Lillehammer, the rural Gudbrandsdalen, the rough Doverfjell plateau with its wild musk ox and many more. In the afternoon you will reach Trondheim and take part in a city tour around the former capital of Norway with its impressive Nidaros Dome (visit subject to opening hours) and which was place for many coronations of past times. You check in into your centrally located hotel and stay for one night.

Day 3: Trondheim – Hurtigruten

After breakfast you set off for a trip on one of the popular sea journeys in the world, with one of the famous costal steamer of “Hurtigruten”! These ships are operating since more than 100 years and drive all along the Norwegian coastline from Bergen in the south to Kirkenes at the Russian border. Still today they are a very important mean of transportation for many small towns in order to transport passengers and goods. While the ship is driving along the cliffy fjord coast of western Norway, the ship passes endless numbers of small islands and villages. On your way, you will stop in Kristiansund, the “city of roses” Molde and the Art Nouveau city Ålesund. You will stay on board of “Hurtigruten” for one night.

Day 4: Hurtigruten – Bergen

The next morning, the ship stops in Florø before continuing without any further stop to Bergen. Like yesterday, you will be able to enjoy the fantastic panorama of mountains, wild coasts, islands, open sea, small fishing villages and fjords! You will be delighted! After your arrival in Bergen, a tour guide will take you on a city tour on which you experience the most beautiful views of Bergen, for example the well-known quarter “Bryggen” which was built by German salesmen. Overnight stay in a centrally located hotel in Bergen.

Day 5: Bergen – Bergen Railway – Oslo

After a rich breakfast you leave Bergen and travel with the well-known Bergen railway from west to east. On your way you will cross the impressive Hardanger plateau. After you arrived in Oslo in the afternoon, you will take part in a city tour. A tour guide will show you all highlights Oslo has to offer, such as Vigeland-Park, the new Opera House, Åkerhus fortress and the Castle. On the island of Bygdøy you will visit the interesting Viking ship museum (entrance fee included).

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The following night you will stay at a centrally located hotel in Oslo.

Day 6: Return flight

Breakfast at the hotel. In the course of the day coach transfer to the airport Oslo-Gardermoen to catch your homeward flight.
