

301 Dream Tour North Cape & Lofoten

This extensive tour offers everything for Scandinavia lovers: from the bustling metropolis through deserted areas to the spectacular coast of Norway with the highlight North Cape and the magnificent Lofoten Islands.

Day 1: Puttgarden-Ängelholm (240 km)

Your journey starts with the ferry crossing Puttgarden - Rødby before arriving in Copenhagen. Here you will have a guided city tour including all interesting sights such as Tivoli, town hall, "Round Tower", castle Amalienborg and "The little Mermaid". After the tour you travel on to Helsingør and continue by ferry to Helsingborg in Sweden. Overnight stay in Ängelholm.

Day 2: Ängelholm-Stockholm-Turku (535 km)

After breakfast your journey continues via Linköping to Stockholm which is located on 14 islands in the world famous archipelago. On a city tour you will see the highlights of the city for example the castle, the Stadhuset or the picturesque old town "Gamla Stan". At around 8 p.m. you will leave the city with a luxurious ferry to Turku. You will spend the night on board.

Day 3: Turku-Helsinki-Joutsa (370 km)

While you enjoy your breakfast you can get pleasure from the fantastic view over the archipelago. After your arrival in Turku you continue to Helsinki. Here a tour guide will show you the city with sights such as the senate place, Sibelius memorial and the fascinating temple church. In the afternoon you will continue to Joutsa where you will stay for one night.

Day 4: Joutsa-Kajaani (400 km)

Breakfast at the hotel. Finland is called "The land of 1000 lakes". We recommend a side trip to Valamen. Here a visit at the orthodox abbey Valamo is recommendable. You continue your journey and arrive in the city of Kajaani where you will stay for one night.

Day 5: Kajaani-Saariselkä (630 km)

Today you will cross the Arctic Circle near Kemijärvi and continue to Saariselkä in Lapland where you will stay for one night.

Day 6: Saariselkä-Nordkapp (420 km)

Today your journey continues via Ivalo near Inari Lake along the popular reindeer road to Karasjok. After having passed along the Porsanger fjord a tunnel under the sea will take you to Magerøya, the North Cape Island. There you will check in into the booked guest house. In the evening you will visit the North Cape Cliff and in case of good weather you will experience a breathtaking view over the Arctic Sea.

Day 7: Nordkapp-Alta (185 km)

The morning hours are yours and can be used for your own interests. In the afternoon you will drive to Alta for a one night's stay. On the way you may do a side trip to Hammerfest, the northernmost city in the world.

Day 8: Alta-Gratangen (450 km)

After breakfast you will continue along the coast line of Kvaenangsbotn and Lyngenfjord to reach Gratangen in the afternoon. Here you will spend the night in a hotel.

Day 9: Gratangen-Mortsund (250 km)

You leave Gratangen after your breakfast and continue to the Lofoten Islands. At additional costs there is the possibility of doing a cruise with the costal steamer of "Hurtigruten" from i.e. Stokmarknes to Svolvær. Overnight stay at a typical Rorbu Hotel in the southern part of the Lofoten Islands.

Day 10: Mortsund-Mo i Rana (290 km)

After breakfast you will experience the wonderful south of the Lofoten Islands. A ferry crossing across the Vestfjord brings you back to the mainland. You cross the Arctic Circle and stay for one night in Mo i Rana.

Day 11: Mo i Rana-Trondheim (470 km)

After breakfast you continue towards the South. Via Levanger, an old trading town, you travel along the Trondheim fjord to Trondheim, the city where the coronation of many of the Norwegian kings took place. Overnight stay in the Trondheim area.

Day 12: Trondheim-Gardermoen (460 km)

After breakfast you have the opportunity to visit Trondheim and the well-known Nidaros Dome. Later on you travel along the lovely Gudbrandstal valley, passing Dombås and Lillehammer and in the late afternoon you reach Gardermoen which is north of Oslo.

Day 13: Gardermoen-Oslo (45 km)

Your day starts with a delicious breakfast. In the following you travel to Oslo where a city guide will show you all highlights of the city such as the town hall, the fort Åkerhus, the museum island Bygdøy and the new opera house. In the evening you take a comfortable night ferry which will bring you to Denmark. Your accommodation for the night will be on board.

Day 14: Arrival in Frederikshavn

After a last breakfast on board you will leave the ship and start your journey back home.
